Module11. Monitoring, Supervision and Evaluation

Organizing Principle

The course walks you through the different policies and procedures in NTP implementation following the chapters of the MOP. This chapter is on Monitoring, Supervision and Evaluation (MSE).

Allot about 2-3 hours for you to finish this module.

Learning Objectives

After studying this module, you should bel able to:

- 3. describe the NTP standard monitoring and supervision tool,
- 4. describe the different procedures in monitoring, supervision and evaluation, and
- 5. compute for, and analyze program indicators.

Learning Activities

 - c. Explain how each of the NTP indicators is computed and how they reflect the performance of the various units:
 - Case Notification Rate
 - TB Case Detection Rate
 - Notification Rate of MDR-TB
 - Treatment Success Rate (all forms)
 - Cure Rate (New Bacteriologically-confirmed)
 - Treatment Success Rate of MDR-TB
 - Percent of bacteriologically confirmed MDR-TB cases with negative culture after 6 months of treatment (interim outcome)
 - Total number of presumptive TB examined

- Percent contribution from non-NTP care providers
- Number of children with TB detected and given treatment and IPT
- Percentage of TB cases in Category A and B areas with HIV counseling and testing aged 15 years old and above
- Percentage of DR-TB cases provided with HIV counselling and testing aged 15 years old and above
- Percent of TMLs within EQA standards
- Percent of DOTS/laboratory facilities with no stock-outs of anti-TB drugs and laboratory supplies in the last 6 months

IV. Read the document "Analysis of NTP Indicators"

As a supplemental reference, the IMPACT Project developed a guide for analyzing computed NTP indicators. Go through it carefully. Note that it does not cover all the possible reasons to explain the resultant figures or trends. Nor should planning for interventions be limited to only those mentioned in the document.

V. Go through Slide Set #11

Go through the slide set as a review of this chapter and module. Post any questions you may have in the discussion forum pertaining to this chapter and module.

VI. Do Exercise #11

Exercise #11 will test your ability to compute for, and do an analysis of the resulting program indicators. Please refer to the *Guide to Exercise #11* for detailed instructions. Remember, if you do not get the answers correctly the first time, go back and review the chapter, then do the exercise again until you can confidently give the correct answers and justify their correctness.
